Century Math Students Score First in Central Region

Century College mathematics students recently scored first out of 16 teams in the Central Region of the American Mathematics Association of Two-Year Colleges' Student Mathematics League Contest.

Normandale Community College ranked second in the contest, and Rochester Community and Technical College ranked third.

Century students ranked 18th in the nation.

Century had seven students among the 20 top scorers in the Central Region. The top 10 Century scorers are Daniel Bles of North St. Paul, Curtis Heyda of White Bear Lake, Wayne Gabrielson of Maplewood, Daniel Doffing of White Bear Lake, Christopher Pepin of Stacy, Nick Milleson of Woodbury, Adam Gibson of St. Paul, Jim Laven of Shoreview, Joseph Dickert of Shoreview and Yitian Li of China.

The highest scoring student among those who have not yet taken calculus was Jim Laven of Shoreview.

The Student mathematics League consists of a series of two written competitions held each year at two-year colleges nationwide. Each contest consists of 20 multiple choice questions that contestants must solve individually in 60 minutes. The problems are from areas such as intermediate and college algebra, geometry, probability, logic, number theory and trigonometry
