## **Century College Math Students Honored**

Century College this year placed second out of 18 teams in the Central Region of the national Student Mathematics League Contest sponsored by the American Mathematics Association of Two-Year Colleges. Century ranked in the top quarter of the participating colleges in the nation.

Daniel Bles of North St. Paul was honored recently for having the highest cumulative score among the 150 Century students who participated in the two rounds of the math contest. He had his name added to the AMATYC plaque for the third time because this is the third time he has been the top scorer.

The Student Mathematics League contest consists of a series of two written competitions held each year at two-year colleges nationwide. Each contest consists of 20 multiple choice questions that contestants must solve individually in 60 minutes. The problems are from areas such as intermediate and college algebra, geometry, probability, logic, number theory and trigonometry.
