Century Hosts Kevin Kling April 20

Minnesota storyteller and author Kevin Kling, best known for his popular commentaries on National Public Radio's *All Things Considered*, will share some of his hilarious and often deeply spiritual stories at Century College on Wednesday, April 20, at 9 a.m. on the East Campus Lincoln Mall.

Born with a deformed left arm, Kling was in a motorcycle accident 10 years ago that robbed him of the use of his right arm. Kling talks about the incident in ways that bring both tears and laughter, combining a powerful sense of observation with a real understanding of what it is like to struggle.

Kling most recently appeared at the History Theatre in St. Paul, where he delivered a series of personal recollections called "A Tale of Twin Cities." His book "The Dog Says How," a collection of his quirky stories, has been chosen as a community-wide book club selection in Northfield.

Kling's appearance is part of the Century College Campus Conference, a day of workshops and presentations by and for students. The conference includes a poetry slam and film competition, plus musical and theater performances.

The event is free and open to the public.
