Century College will present *The Seagull* by Anton Chekov, a riveting portrait of a theatre family at the turn of the 1900s, over two weekends in April.

Performances will be Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30 p.m. on April 15 and 16, and also April 22 and 23. A Sunday matinee will be performed on April 17 at 2 p.m.
