Century Hosts Recycling Days October 21 and 22

If you are wanting to get rid of old computer monitors, keyboards, printers, microwaves, cell phones, stereos and other electronic items that have been cluttering up your basement and garage, Century College students have a deal for you.

Student members of the Century College Information Technology Association (CCITA) have teamed up with 5R Processors of Ladysmith, Wis., and are hosting two community electronics recycling days at Century on Friday, Oct. 21, and Saturday, Oct. 22. They will accept your items free of charge. The hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Oct. 21, and 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Oct. 22.

You can drop off items on Century College's West Campus in the northeast corner of the parking lot. As CCITA Club members, the students are hosting the recycling days as a goodwill gesture for the community.

Acceptable items (in addition to those listed above) include laptops, copy machines, fax machines, televisions, wire and cabling, cash registers, aluminum cans, AV equipment, medical equipment, game consoles, appliances and DVD and VHS players.

In addition, 5R Processors will be providing hard-drive cleansing for only \$10. Freon-containing units such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers will be accepted for a fee of \$25.
